POLICE STATION



To complete its public service campus, the City of West Lafayette wanted to construct a new police station next to its existing pre-cast concrete city hall.

PROJECT APPROACH

- Designed 26,000 s.f. facility with functions separated into three levels.
- Basement is evidence processing, fitness, and staff locker rooms.
- First level with administration and selected services divisions, including four-bay sally port, limited detainee access, and controlled public access at main entrance lobby.
- Patrol division and investigations on second level.
- Exterior materials fundamentally compatible with City Hall: glazed sections and pre-cast concrete panels.
- Exterior design integrates within municipal campus.

- Functional efficiencies within progressive and efficient facility design.
- Seamless fit within the City's public service campus.
- Fully-integrated electronic security systems and state-of-the-art technologies.
